Travelling by Train or Tram

The easiest and fastest way to navigate Ireland is by using the DART – Dublin’s electric train system or by trams using The Luas. The closest train station is Pearse Street and the closest tram station is Dawson Street (Green Line). To plan your journey to these destinations, please visit <https://citymapper.com/dublin>

You can buy tickets for Dublin’s trains, trams and buses at individual stations or on buses. However, it is cheaper to use a ‘Leap Card’ to travel around Dublin on public transport. 
